# Chip n' Chatter

## Rules

Rule 8. Advice - **Revised (Please see revision in blue below.)**

ADVICE is any counsel or suggestion that could influence a player in determining his play, the choice of a club or the method of making a stroke.

8-1. Advice

During a stipulated round, a player must not:

- a. give advice to anyone in the competition playing on the course other than his partner, or
- b. ask for advice from anyone other than his partner

8-2. Indicating Line of Play

a. Other Than on Putting Green

Except on the putting green, a player may have the line of play indicated to him by anyone, but no one may be positioned by the player on or close to the line or an extension of line beyond the hole while the stroke is being made. Any mark placed by the player or with his knowledge to indicate the line must be removed before the stroke is made.

Exception: Flagstick attended or held up.

b. On the Putting Green

When the player's ball is on the putting green, the player, or his partner may, before but not during the stroke, point out a line for putting, but in so doing the putting green must not be touched. A mark must not be placed anywhere to indicate a line for putting

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF RULE**

Match play - loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes

**RULES AND DECISIONS (This comes from the USGA's official Web site)**

8-1/2 Exchanging Distance Information

Information regarding the distance between two objects is public information and not advice. It is therefore permissible for players to exchange information relating to the distance between two objects.

For example, a player may ask anyone, including his fellow competitor, the distance between his ball and the hole.

The latest version of 2012 - 2015 The Rules of Golf take effect on Jan. 1, 2012.
